## **VOLUNTEER INSTRUCTIONS**



Thank you for participating in Test Drive...Next Stop Reality! Your job as a volunteer will be to guide students through making purchases while they create a monthly "adult" budget.

Students are approximately 25 years old, have chosen an occupation, and have determined their net monthly income. They may be single, single with a child, married, or married with a child. These important life details should be displayed on their name tags. If not, the front page of their Student Status Packets will list this information. Their life status will be a factor in what they will need to purchase from your station.

## **Police Encounter**

Your task is to patrol the event, handing out good citizen rewards and fines for violations.

You may use your discretion when giving out the various Police Encounter tickets to students. For Example:

- You will receive "tickets" containing a mixture of violations and good citizen rewards. Give these out at random to students as you see fit. Students have been informed that if they get a violation/good citizen reward this is simply luck of the draw.
  - If you see a student picking up trash or going out of their way to be kind, you may use a blank ticket to customize what you "caught" them doing and give them a good citizen reward.
  - If you see a student running or being rude in line, you may use a blank ticket to give them a fine. Ideas could be running, disorderly conduct, tailgating, etc. **Have fun with it!**

## What to do when handing out Police Encounter Tickets:

- Explain to students what ticket you are giving them, whether it be a Good Citizen Reward or a ticket for a violation.
- Have students flip to the Police Encounters section on page 5 of their Road Map and record a description of the ticket or reward and amount paid.
- If a student received a Good Citizen Reward, have them record it in their Transaction Register and add it to their balance.
- If a student received a fine, have them record it in their Transaction Register and subtract it from their balance.

Acknowledge the transaction by placing a stamp in the right column of the Police Encounters section of their Road Map.
