## **VOLUNTEER INSTRUCTIONS**



Thank you for participating in Test Drive...Next Stop Reality! Your job as a volunteer will be to guide students through making purchases while they create a monthly "adult" budget.

Students are approximately 25 years old, have chosen an occupation, and have determined their net monthly income. They may be single, single with a child, married, or married with a child. These important life details should be displayed on their name tags. If not, the front page of their Student Status Packets will list this information. Their life status will be a factor in what they will need to purchase from your station.

## **Entertainment**

Each student will visit your table to pay for **two** entertainment options of their choosing.

Ask, "What do you like to do for fun?"

Display the Entertainment Station Guides on the table for the student to observe and choose from.

- Briefly discuss the different entertainment options. Explain that we all need to set aside money for fun and entertainment, but the amount depends on our personal budget.
- Students will need to make **two selections** for their monthly entertainment budget. They may choose two of the same option, if desired or necessary.
- Options have prices listed for Single, Single with Child, Married, and Married with Child.
- Students may choose more than two selections if they want.

For each choice, the student will record the cost on their Road Map and total it. They should then record that amount on the Transaction Register of their Student Status Packet and subtract it from their balance.

Acknowledge the transaction by placing a stamp in the right column of the Entertainment section of their Road Map.
